

WHAT TO EXPECT

Our trained corps of Guides (Docents) will develop your tour by selecting works of art related to the theme you've selected. Once groups arrive and are divided, they will be led by a Docent who will guide them in exploring works of art throughout the building. You will not need to bring additional materials. Groups may see different works of art, but they will tour the Museum using the same theme. At the end of the visit, groups will return to the entrance where they started.

CHAPERONES

We require one chaperone/teacher for every 10 students. To navigate our galleries comfortably, we must divide groups larger than 15. Our staff members will divide your group according to the number of guides available when you arrive, and at least one chaperone will be asked to accompany each group.

SAFETY

For your safety and the safety of the art, we ask that teachers and chaperones remain with their group at all times. Works of art are more fragile than they appear; **please remind your students that it is important not to touch**. Flash photography is prohibited in the galleries, as some works of art are sensitive to light. Photographs are not permitted in some special exhibitions. School rules are also good rules for the Museum.

GIFT SHOP

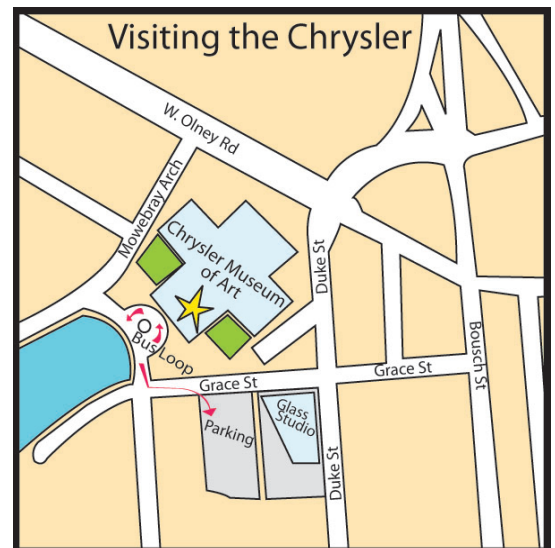
After your visit, students are welcome to visit the Museum Shop in groups of 10 or less while under the supervision of an adult.

FOOD AND DRINK

Food and drink are not permitted in the galleries. The Museum does not have an interior space for groups to eat; however, we may be able to accommodate small groups with requests made in advance. In addition, groups may choose to eat in either of the two exterior gardens at the Museum, weather permitting (shown in green).

BUSES

Buses should drop off and pick up their groups in the circular driveway in front of the Museum (see pink arrows). Buses may park in the parking lot on Grace Street, immediately across from the Museum (indicated in gray).
